Silpakorn University International College (SUIC) would like to announce the details on direct admission requirements for the academic year 1/2018 (Intake 1). The information can be seen hereunder:

1. Graduate Programs and Number of Students:

Remark : SUIC reserves the right to cancel the admission if the number of applicants or those who pass the entrance examination are less than the number of seats expected in SUIC enrollment plan.

2. Qualifications of the Applicants

2.1. Doctor of Philosophy

- 2.1.1. An applicant must complete a Master's degree (or equivalent) in either International Business or Business Administration major from an academic institute accredited by Ministry of Education, Royal Thai Government or a major that has been approved by the SUIC Executive Committee/Board of Graduate Study);
- 2.1.2. An applicant must achieve a minimum GPA of 3.20 or obtain a minimum of two (2) years working experience in related field;
- 2.1.3. An interesting dissertation proposal and a Statement of Purpose stating the reasons to study in the applied program in 1-2 pages of an A-4.

2.2. Master of Business Administration

- 2.2.1. An applicant must complete a Bachelor's degree (or equivalent) from an academic institute accredited by Ministry of Education, Royal Thai Government;

- 2.2.2. An applicant must achieve a minimum GPA of 2.75 or obtain a minimum of two (2) years working experience in related field;
- 2.2.3. A Statement of Purpose stating the reasons to study in the applied program in 1 page of an A-4.

3. Schedule and Application Period

3.1. Application Periods

3.3.1. Apply in Person: 8-Jan-2018 to 16-Mar-2018

3.3.2. Apply by Postal Mail: 8-Jan-2018 to 14-Mar-2018

SUIC only accepts the application form that is received by the postmark.

3.2. Required Documents (Certified true copy on every page)

3.2.1. A completely filled-in and signed application form with one of 1-inch size photo attached. The application form can be downloaded at www.suic.org.

3.2.2. Application fee of THB 1,200. The applicant who applies by postal mail shall attach all required documents and a copy of bank deposit slip or a copy of money order mentioning the applicant's name with the application form.

3.2.3. Copies of official transcript and diploma of former education. Applicant who graduated from the university / institute abroad must submit "Degree Equivalency Certificate" issued by the Ministry of Education, Royal Thai Government.

3.2.4. A copy of government identification document: Passport (for foreign nationalities) or Identification Card (for Thai nationality).

3.2.5. A copy of House's Registration (for Thai nationality).

3.2.6. Three (3) sets of facing-forward photo in 1-inch size.

3.2.7. A Statement of Purpose stating the reasons to study in the applied program in 1 page of an A-4.

3.2.8. Applicant who achieves a score of either TOEFL or IELTS within 2 years following the score in the below table is exempted to take SUIC English Proficiency Test.
